The Special Purpose Operating Report for the November period includes the operating results for the 34 day period from October 28, 2015 to November 30, 2015. Rural/Metro Corporation, which is the parent company of Rural/Metro of California, Inc. (which the Santa Clara 911 Operations are a part of), was a party in a merger with AMR Holdco, Inc., an indirect subsidiary of Envision Healthcare Corporation. The merger closed on October 28, 2015.
