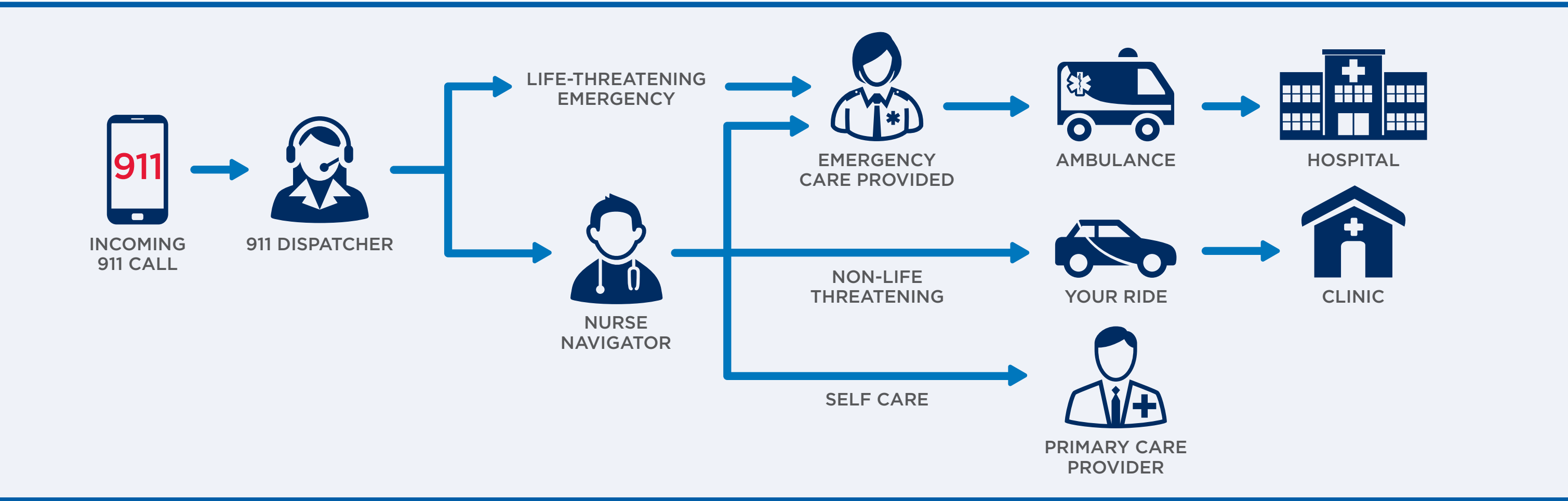


AMR 911 NURSE NAVIGATION PROGRAM

Under the physician protocols, this may include transportation to local urgent care, virtual care with a physician or self-care at home (or in some cases a return to 911 ambulance dispatch).
