When you call 911 during a medical event, you may not need an ambulance trip to your local hospital emergency department. The City of Evansville's new program, developed in collaboration with the local EMS provider American Medical Response and program pioneer Global Medical Response, gives 911 call takers the option to connect you with a Nurse Navigator to figure out the right type of care option for your situation using physician protocols, including how and where you get it.
