

## **ASK EVERY PATIENT:**

### **Do you have any of these symptoms?**

- Fever or chills
- Headache, joint or muscle aches
- Stomach pain, diarrhea or vomiting
- Abnormal bleeding

### **If YES ask:**

- Traveled to a country in West Africa (Guinea, Liberia, and Sierra Leone)
- Had contact with a person known or suspected of having Ebola

### **IF YES to both questions:**

#### **IMMEDIATELY**

- Establish blood and body fluid precautions
- Inform receiving facility that patient screen positive for Ebola
- If possible – avoid invasive procedures or those likely to cause blood or body fluid splatter (IV, airway, suctioning, nebulized medications)

### **If NO to either:**

- PPE appropriate to patient presentation
- Assessment and care according to protocol

## **NOTIFY EVHC CLINICAL HOTLINE AND RECEIVING FACILITY OF POSITIVE SCREENING**

### **Crew Preparation:**

- All caregivers will don PPE double checking for integrity issues or exposed body parts

### **Protocol / Supplies:**

- Wash Hands
- Goggles
- N95 or P100 Respirator
- Shoe Covers
- Gloves
- Fluid-resistant Gown
